**WHO:** Brand new players to experienced, ages 5 - 14, Engaging parents as caddies, guides, mentors and team coaches

**WHAT:** This 8 week on-course, developmental program focuses on transforming a family unit into a team that learns about golf together. The program shows the parents and families how to aid their children's golf development as guides, caddies, fans and coaches. In addition to team building, leadership skills and problem solving are secondary benefits of this program. We will show the golfers, the coaches (i.e. parents and other family members) and caddies when and how to lead, assist, and make the best on-course decisions. In the end, this program will help the family grow closer together, will help the family learn about golf, and will help the family have fun with golf.

**WHERE:** Fox Run Country Club, Cross Winds Par 3, Willow Creek Golf Club, Bonnie Brae, Legacy Pines, Botany Woods Par 3, & Southern Oaks.

**TEAMS:** Teams are comprised of 4-6 players of approximate experience level and age groups of 5-7, 8-10, & 11-14.

**PLACE & TIME:** The playing sessions will begin at **4 pm on Sunday afternoons** using a rotation of the courses listed above. The Team Series will begin on **Sunday Sep 25th** and will conclude on **Sunday Nov 13th**. The full schedule of course locations for all outings will be provided at the parents orientation — date TBA.

**COST:** \$85 per player

**REQUIRED:** Players must have a set of golf clubs and a parent or guardian present to serve as a caddie.
